

WAARC April 10, 2018 meeting minutes

President Dino, KLOS, called the meeting to order and welcomed all. The "Hour of Power" before the meeting was used to provide a question and answer opportunity for new (or any) hams with discussion from "old" hams. The next Hour of Power will be used for Field Day planning. The general meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. There were 40 attending. The "Brag Can" was passed around for introductions and comments. Dino gave recognition to all the members of the recent technician class and then presented the instructors with certificates of recognition from the ARRL. He also introduced BJ, KN4KXF, as the new club PIO.
