

WAARC February 11 2025 meeting minutes

The Hour of Power session and general meeting were performed via ZOOM video and NOT in-person at the JCC Bruton Fire Station due to weather concerns. The HOP was presented by Jack, KY4EA, providing information on antenna builds that could support the Spring Wire event. He described the event and two antenna builds, one for 6m and one for 10m. Jack was planning to schedule a group build if there was interest.

President Kerry, NH2A, was at HamCation so Vice President Will, K4MI, called the general meeting to order. He welcomed visitors and 2 new members. There were 53 attending. The minutes from the last meeting (posted on the groups.io site and the club web site) were approved by motion and vote. The treasurer's report was posted on the Groups.io web site.
